1 Project Description

In December 2005, the County of San Diego Department of Public Works started Phase 2 of this project. Phase 2 involves improvements 1 mile south of Banbury Drive to Cole Grade Road.

2 Upcoming Construction Activity

During the month of August, the contractor is scheduled to perform the following daytime operations:

Segment 1: Valley Center Grade to Woods Valley Road

- Complete concrete curb transition for storm drain inlets
- Install wildlife fence

Segment 2: Woods Valley Road to Old Road

- Repair concrete
- Install fences and gates
- Complete storm drain work near Sunday Drive/Moosa Creek
- Construct final grade in graded dirt parkways and slopes
- Continue underground utility conversions

Segment 3: Old Road to Miller Road

- Repair concrete
- Install sidewalk and pedestrian ramps at Lilac Road
- Modify turn lanes at Lilac Road
- Install fences and gates
- Conduct final grade in graded dirt parkways and slopes
- Continue underground utility conversions

Segment 4: Miller Road to Cole Grade Road

- Repair concrete
- Install fences and gates
- Conduct final grade in graded dirt parkways and slopes
- Continue underground utility conversions

For all segments, continue maintaining and installing erosion control devices as necessary.

4 Construction and Traffic Impacts

General Traffic Control Info

With 4 lanes now open on Valley Center Road, please keep in mind that construction is still in progress. Occasional lane closures will occur during working hours to complete median and shoulder work, but the public will have access to all lanes during non-working hours and weekends.

Please continue to observe the posted speed limit of 35 MPH through the construction zone. Traffic fines are doubled in construction zones. For safety and to avoid penalties, please slow down and use caution when traveling through the construction zone.
