
What's an EXPRESS visit?

An **EXPRESS** visit is when a patient gets STD tests, STD results, STD treatments, or hepatitis or H1N1 vaccination(s) without getting a physical examination.

Why would I want an EXPRESS visit?

You might get your tests, results, treatments, and/or hepatitis or H1N1 vaccination(s) done more quickly.

Can I have an EXPRESS visit?

If you have no symptoms of an STD, including HIV, and are here just for tests, tests results, or a hepatitis vaccination, then you might be able to have an **EXPRESS** visit. You might also be able to have an **EXPRESS** visit if you are here because the clinic called you in for treatment. Sometimes patients who would like an **EXPRESS** visit are advised to have a regular visit instead.

When should I NOT have an EXPRESS visit?

You should **NOT** have an **EXPRESS** visit if any of the following applies to you:

- You have symptoms you think might possibly be from an STD*.
- You are here because someone you had sex with said that he or she has an STD*.
- You are because a public health advisor told you that you were exposed to an STD*.
- You are a woman who wants a pelvic examination.
- You are a woman who is pregnant.

**Including HIV, if you have never been told that you are HIV-positive.*

What are the symptoms of STDs?

STD symptoms can include burning or irritation when urinating (peeing); discharge (drip or ooze) from the head of the penis; abnormal or foul-smelling discharge from the vagina; itching; pain in the belly; pain in the scrotum (balls); skin rash, sores, or bumps; hair loss; swollen lymph nodes (glands); sore throat; fever; and generally not feeling well.

What if I'm not sure whether my symptoms are from an STD or HIV?

Then you should have a regular visit, **NOT** an **EXPRESS** visit.

If I can have an EXPRESS visit, do I have to have one?

No. You can always choose to have a regular visit.

Is the fee for an EXPRESS visit different than the fee for a regular visit?

No. The fee is the same—\$15. We will waive the fee if you are unable to pay.

What happens during an EXPRESS visit?

It depends on what you need. You will answer some questions to help us know what you need on the "STD Clinic Visit Questionnaire."

How do I find out if I can have an EXPRESS visit?

Just fill out the form you were given and return it to the registration desk. We'll let you know!
