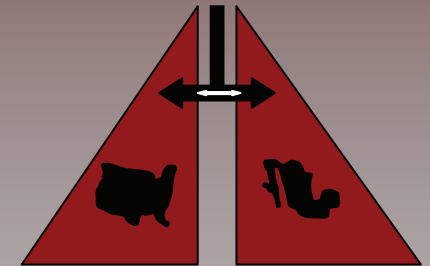

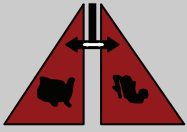

A BINATIONAL TUBERCULOSIS REFERRAL PROGRAM

What is CURE-TB?

CURE-TB is a referral program for tuberculosis patients and their contacts moving between the U.S. and Mexico. Services are available to patients and providers in the United States and Mexico. This program provides guidance for patients and facilitates the exchange of information between providers in the U.S. and Mexico. CURE-TB is part of the TB Control Program of San Diego County.

What is the primary goal of CURE-TB?

The primary goal of CURE-TB is to improve continuity of care for active TB cases and their contacts traveling between the U.S. and Mexico.

What types of referrals can U.S. providers send to the CURE-TB Program?

Referrals for:

- ◆ Patients with active or suspected TB who are moving to or spending more than one month in Mexico.
- ◆ Contacts that move between the United States and Mexico
- ◆ Contacts living in Mexico who have been exposed to a confirmed TB case living in the U.S.
- ◆ Source case finding for an index case in the U.S. when there is reasonable suspicion of active disease in a person living in Mexico.
- ◆ Requests for a patient's clinical history while living in Mexico.

Who can use CURE-TB services?

1. Any **medical provider** within the United States or Mexico can refer a patient to the CURE-TB Program.
2. **Patients** with TB, who cross the U.S.-Mexican border are highly encouraged to call our toll-free telephone number to request information about how to continue their TB care.
