HOUSING

Emergency Housing: **Center for Social Support and Education – (619) 325-2773**
 Provides 100 emergency beds for up to 44 days.

Licensed Group Homes: **Fraternity House, Inc. - (760) 736-0292**
 Provides 20 beds through Fraternity and Michaelle houses for consumers who need 24-hour care. Six beds targeted for HIV/AIDS women with children.

Transitional Group Homes: **St. Vincent de Paul Village, Inc. - (619) 667-2610**
 Provides 26 beds through Josue houses I, II, and III for consumers who are ambulatory and self-sufficient.

PACTO Latino AIDS Organization - (619) 725-0946
 Provides transitional housing for consumers who are ambulatory and self-sufficient. Provides 17 beds through Casa Truax and Casa del Sol.

Permanent Housing: **Community Housingworks - (760) 432-6878**
 Provides 21 permanent housing units for consumers and their families through the Marisol Project and 4 units at Old Grove. Some support services are provided.

Townspeople - Wilson Avenue Apartments - (619) 295-8802
 Provides 8 permanent housing units for consumers at the Wilson Ave. Apartments. Some support services are provided.

Sunburst Apartments – (619) 692-2077
 Provides 3 permanent units for transitional aged consumers, ages 18-24 in the San Diego metro area.

South Bay Community Services - (619) 420-3620
 Provides 12 permanent housing units for consumers and their families through the La Posada Project. Case management and support services are provided.

 Provides up to 5 permanent housing units (2 bedroom, or 3 bedroom depending upon availability) for consumers and their families in San Marcos.
