

IMPORTANT VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Checking the Status of Your Voter Registration

Q: Have you recently completed a voter registration form?

If so, you can **check the status of your registration** on this website by clicking “Check Your Voter Registration Status” at the home page. At the prompt, enter your street number, date of birth, and zip code. This will confirm the status of your registration and your political party affiliation.

Q: What information is legally required to process your voter registration?

State and federal law require your:

- First and last name
- Complete residence address
- CA driver’s license or CA ID number. If you do not have a CA driver’s license or ID card, the last 4 digits of your Social Security number
- Date of birth
- Signature

If any of these items are missing, the Registrar of Voters must obtain them in order for your registration to be valid.

Q: What other information is requested by state law?

State law requests certain information in order to better serve you as a voter.

- Place of birth
- A political party or an indication that you decline to state a political party preference.

If you do not provide this information, it will not invalidate your registration. However, the Registrar will send you a “Missing Information” notice and attempt to collect this information to ensure you receive the proper election materials.

Q: If I am registered to vote, what can I expect to receive?

If you are registered to vote, you will receive a **Voter Notification Card** confirming your name, address, political party affiliation, if any, and the first day you are entitled to vote. Your name will appear on the roster of voters for any election held 15 or more days after the date on your Voter Notification Card. You will receive a sample ballot booklet and other election materials.
