

## CANDIDATE FILING CALENDAR – June 8, 2010

**NOTE:** Candidates who wish to run for a partisan office and obtain the *party's nomination* on June 8, must have been registered with their party for 3 months and no other party for 12 months prior to the date the declaration of candidacy is filed during the nomination period.

Candidates who wish to run for a partisan office as an *"Independent"* (not affiliated with any qualified party) will not be on the ballot until the November 2, 2010 General Election. (Candidate filing for "Independent Candidates" begins on 06/07/10.) The candidate **cannot** have been registered to vote in California with any qualified political party since 10/02/09.
