February 23 (Days Before Election: 103)	Petitions in-lieu – Last Day	Any candidate who wishes to offset the filing fee <b>Note:</b> San Diego Unified School District: Last day for petitions in-lieu is March 9 <sup>th</sup> 2012.
March 9 (Days Before Election: 88)	Nomination Period – Last Day	<b><u>ALL</u></b> offices <b>except San Diego City Council (ask San Diego City Clerk for details).</b>
March 14 (Days Before Election: 83)	Nomination Period – 5-Day Extension Last Day	Applicable only if incumbent has failed to file by March 9. (Extension <b><u>does not apply</u></b> to Central Committees or to an incumbent for <b><u>any</u></b> office.)

**NOTE:** \* Any candidate for county central committee or county council shall have been registered with the political party of the nomination for which he or she seeks continuously for not less than three months prior to the time of presentation of his/her Declaration of Candidacy, or, if eligible to register for less than three months, for as long as he or she has been eligible to register to vote in California. The candidate shall not have been registered as affiliated with a political party other than that party for 12 months immediately prior to the filing of the Declaration of Candidacy. (E.C. §8001)
