88	August 6	Registrar of Voters to receive resolution(s) requesting consolidation, services, etc. Ballot text (limited to 75 words) must be included in the resolution. (10403; Education Code 5322)
88	August 6	Tax rate statement (if applicable) is due at Registrar of Voters Office. (9401)
82	August 12 (approx.)	Registrar of Voters to publish a Notice of Argument Deadline. (9163, 9316, 9502)
78	August 16	Impartial analysis is due at Registrar of Voters Office. (9160, 9313, 9500)
76	August 18	Arguments <u>in favor of</u> OR <u>against</u> the proposition are due at Registrar of Voters Office. (9163, 9316, 9502)
75	August 19	Registrar of Voters to “trade” direct arguments with author from each side for preparation of rebuttals. (9167)
68	August 26	Rebuttal arguments due at Registrar of Voters Office. (9167, 9317, 9504)
56 to 41	September 7 to September 22	Ballots typeset, proofed and printed.
29	October 4	First day absentee/mail ballots are available. (3001)
15	October 18	Last day to register to vote in this election. (2102)
7	October 26	Last day to request an absentee/mail ballot <i>through the mail</i> . (3001)
6 to 0	October 27 to November 2	<i>In person</i> at the Registrar of Voters Office. (3021)
0	November 2	ELECTION DAY – Polls open from 7 am to 8 pm.
DAYS AFTER THE ELECTION	DATE	EVENT
+ 28	November 30	Certified results available after the official canvass is completed. Major elections (Primary or General of an even year, for example) may require 28 days; stand-alone or smaller elections require much less time. (15300)

**PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD
FOR THE
NOVEMBER 2, 2010
GENERAL ELECTION**

State law provides for a 10-calendar-day "public review period" for all candidates' ballot occupational designations, candidates' statements of qualifications, ballot measure analyses, arguments, rebuttals and other materials before printing the Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlet.

The California Elections Code further defines this review period, with a distinct period for each document filed with the Registrar of Voters.

During this period, any voter who believes any portion of these materials to be false, misleading or inconsistent with state law may seek a writ of mandate or injunction requiring any or all of the material to be amended or deleted.

July 28 to August 6 Local candidates in a "run-off" election – changes due by July 27
August 9 to August 18: Candidates filed by August 6
August 12 to August 23: Candidates filed by August 11 (during the 5-day extension)

August 9 to August 18: Statements filed by August 6

County Counsel's Impartial Analyses of Local Propositions

August 17 to August 26 Analyses due by August 16

Ballot Arguments "in Favor of" or "Against" Local Propositions

August 19 to August 30 Arguments due by August 18

Rebuttals to Ballot Arguments "in Favor of" or "Against" local propositions

August 27 to September 6 Rebuttals due August 26
